FAYETTE, Miss.—Two more white men, one with a submachine gun in his possession, were arrested yesterday following assassination threats against Negro Mayor Charles Evers.

The latest arrests came after Dale Walton, 48, former head of a little-known Ku Klux Klan group, was picked up in Fayette-Tuesday night in a gun-laden car near a shopping center owned by Evers. Walton was charged with speeding and carrying concealed weapons.

Evers said he received three anonymous telephone

Evers said he received three anonymous telephone calls Tuesday warning he had been marked for death. Federal officers said two other whites had been in the car with Walton before his arrest. The two arrested yesterday were Rohby Haywood, 18, and Parkern and Control as submachine gun in Haywood's possession. Police said the two faced charges of violating the Federal Gun Control Act.
