Texas Klansman Resigns, Assails 'Blackballing'

HOUSTON, April 1 (UPI)

Texas Fiery Knights Imperial Wizard Scott Monroe Nelson resigned Wednesday warning other Klansmen to go underground or be blackballed by their neighbors and the business community.

Nelson, who formed the Fiery Knights as a splinter group of the Ku Klux Klan four years ago, said he has been constantly harrassed because of his outspoken views on black rights and communism.

"I've been blackballed myself and my family has and
I've decided to resign due
to the lack of loyalty and
brotherhood and unification
among the members in different Klans," Nelson said.
"I would suggest that other
Klansmen stay underground
and not reveal themselves
as Klansmen because it
would not do any good."
