Radical lawyer William Kunstler recently regaled a "political seminar" in Dallas (no less!) with some vintage Kunstlerisms. John and Robert Kennedy, in his opinion, were "two of the most dangerous men in America," and he said he wasn't "entirely upset" by their murders.

And then he dropped this gem: "I don't disagree with murder sometimes, especially political assassinations."

This is not by any means the first time that Kunstler has given his public blessing to violence and lawlessness, and his rantings have several times been called to the attention of the bar association here.
