

**Unit Urged to Decide  
On New Kennedy Study**

Washington, Sept. 28 (UPI)—  
Rep. Theodore E. Kupferman  
(R-N.Y.) today proposed a con-  
gressional committee be creat-  
ed to decide if there should be  
a new investigation into the as-  
sassination of President Ken-  
nedy.  
Kupferman said he planned to  
introduce a resolution to that  
effect in the House because of  
what he described as a "new  
wave of criticism" of the War-  
ren Commission and its report  
on the assassination.
