

Kup Sees Hushup Over JFK Probe

Washington, April 12 (UPI)—
Theodore R. Kupferman (R-N.Y.)
charged the Johnson Administration today with being party to a
"conspiracy of silence" in its re-
fusal to examine evidence in the
Kennedy assassination. Kupfer-
man, who was refused access to
autopsy photographs and X-rays
which the family of President
John F. Kennedy turned over to
the Nation Archives, reintroduced
a resolution calling for a Con-
gressional committee to decide
whether the investigation of the
assassination should be reopened.
