

Kup Sees Hushup Over JFK Probe

Washington April 5 (UPI)—Theodore R. Kupferman (R-N.Y.) said yesterday the Johnson administration today, with being party to a "conspiracy of silence" in its refusal to examine evidence in the Kennedy assassination. Kupferman, who was refused access to autopsy photographs and X-rays which the family of President John F. Kennedy turned over to the National Archives, reintroduced a resolution calling for a Congressional committee to decide whether the investigation of the assassination should be reopened.
