U.S. INQUIRY IS URGED ON WARREN REPORT

UN WARKEN KEPUKI Special io The New York Times WASHIINGTON, Sept. 28-Representative Thiodore R. Kupferman asked Congress Wednesday to conduct its own investigation into the adequacy of the Warren report on Presi-dent Kennedy's assassination. Citing recent books and arti-cles critical of the report, the Manhattan Republican called for the creation of a 10-member joint Senate-House committee to review the Warren Commis-sion's work. The committee, composed of five members from each house, would first determine whether there is a need to go beyond the Warren Commission's ind-tion. This would be based on a review of the commission's find-ings and also the critical writ-ings and outside data.
