Dear George Connergan,

Please bear in mind that I have to be abed about 6 p.m. and that means have eaten supper before 5 p.m. in your plans. You won't be too early. I'm up early.

Go to Baltimore on I95. When you get to the beltway, I695, enter it immediately, to the right, before you get to the other side and the harbor tunnel, which would take you to Washington. The sign may indicate "Towson." Long time since I saw it. The direction is probably west. Stay on it until exit 16. You be alerted to in advance because there are three bridges at it. Take it to the west. There will be some signs saying Frederick. It become I70. US 40W joins it for a while. When you are inside of Frederick, you'll see a large truck stop-I70Hotel on the right just before going under the bridge that carries State 355. After going under that bridge you'll see a ballpark on the right. Immediately after that is a split. I70 goes straight. Take US40W which splits there, to your right. In a few minutes you'll see on the left the large building of the insurance company and almost immediately a Holiday Inn sign, also on the left. You are then coming up to the US40W turnoff. That is at West Patrick St. Cross the bridge over that street and exit, going to the Holiday Inn. When you get, as you do almost immediately to the corner where the Inn is, Laughman's Lane, turn onto it and go past the Inn on that street. In less than a mile you come to an all-way stop, at Hookstown Road. Turn left on it for about two miles, until you are going up the mountain. After you start up the mountain, in that village, after about the distance of four city blocks, the first street on the right is Old Receiver Road. Turn onto it for about 2 city blocks and you see our mailbox at the end of the lane that goes to the house on;y. Go through the carport to the kitchen door. Our phone is 4XX2S 473-8186
