Dear Mr. Lonergan,

I have no pictures of any of those about whom you ask because I regard none of them as part of the actualities of the assassinations.

<sup>W</sup>Kimble is all lies all the time. Not uncommon in the field, he has made these things up for a bit of cheap fame.

However, the New Orleans paper and/or the wire services have pictures of him.

I know about Gale but I also know nothing that connects him with anything in the assassinations.

I can do you no good with John Davis.

And I do not believe the various Liberto stories so I have no Liberto pictures. I am not aware of any being used in the Memphis papers but the New Orleans paper may have one because of his family there and the stories and his death.

On its face that particular story has no credibility. No assassins ever behave that way. It is crazy.

That story first surfaced when Bill Sartor wrote it but it could not be substantiated then and has not been since then.

Your letter is unclear with regard to the enclosed Miami police report, but I never had any interest in any of the man named in it so I have no files on them and no pictures. But again, some of them did appear in the papers, esp. Miami.

Subject was born in Havana, Cuba on 10-23-31.

From 1955 through December 1958, he was bodyguard to Emilio RIVERO Agüero's family. RIVERO was congressman during the Batista Regime.

Subject came to this country on 6-26-59. He is now living at 2910 N.W. 10 Avenue. He is married and has two daughters.

Subject, during his exile in the United States, has been involved with several Cuban groups in gun running and arranging for several trips that have been made to Cuba.

He was an associate of Eladio Del VALLE but left his group because he felt that several of the men were F. Castro's agents. He has been approached by J. GONZALES Cartas and Humberto Rodriguez for Revolutionary purposes and he feels that he can infiltrate this group and therefore be helpful to the police.

He knows of a man named Carlos SARRAGA, SW 16th Terr. & 30th Avenue, Phone HI 6 1709, who is trying to consolidate different Cuban groups into one and afterwards oppose and discredit Miro Cardona. Sarraga has some arms either at his house or hidden some place else.

Subject is now working with a group (no name) headed by one Manuel Iuiza. This group has made several trips to Cuba on the last trip they stole a boat and brought two militia men to Miami. The head of the group, Iuiza, is very Anti-American, holds Socialist indoctrination classes for his men and wants nothing to do with the C.I.A. or any other U.S. Agency.

Under Iuiza, the group is now planning to make another raid on Cuba within the next 30 days. The objective is to sink a Russian ship by placing explosives underwater.

Subject believes they will attempt this and he wants no part in it unless approved by C.I.A.

Subject wants to contact the C.I.A. and feels he can be useful to them.


I have enclosed your cheque back to you in the amount of \$40.00.
