You list of the books is correct but it does not identify the different editions. For example, I published four printings of Whitewash before Dell reprinted it, which you include, but you give only one edition of Whitewash IV. One was published at Hyattstown, republication was at Frederick.

The other Post Mortems were parts of the final book that was printed. They were limited zerox editions, some uncorrected. I may have some in storage, probably not all. If I have any the cost of replacing them locally would be a little more than 17¢ a page, a very high price, so I'm not searching until I heard from you further on this.

I'm keeping copies for archival deposit, no other purpose.

While I am aware of the essentially meaningless manner of bibliographies to list a city, which does not enable the user to locate a publisher, you will be creating useless futilities in giving as our address the tiny village we left almost 12 years ago, one that does not even have a post office. I suggest you use a footnote to avoid the waste of time of those who may use your bibliography.

Only Oswald in New Orleans is out of print.
