Do I remember you correctly from having gotten me a transcript of the CBS four-part videocassette?

In answer to your letter of 4/24, the two parts of POST MORTEM completed are in limited (xerox) editions only, the third part is not yet written. It is researched.

We do make copies available to collectors and serious scholars upon written promise that they will neither use nor permit use of any of the contents until after we can get the work printed and then in accord with the copyright. It is a simple matter to duplicate my well-footnoted work, and it is far too common, hence the restriction, which in most cases is not because we are apprehensive about the purchasers but of those whose work is unoriginal.

The cost may present you with a problem. For both parts it is \$42.00, including insurance.

In practise, should you want this work, what it means is that you may now read it but no more than that. And, of course, keep it.

If you do, under these circumstances, write me as above, include your check, and I'll send both parts. I've just had a few more copies made.
