Your 52-86 of 115 copies of FBI 12/7/78 releases.

First, I've just heard from \*in that the second batch, today's, is of 18cartons each two feet long.

53, Serial 62-2606, says see note page 3. Only 2 pages sent. Jim and I are still in court on Tins's pictures in RIK case. Can use anything on Tins.

54- 62-109090 unrecorded 3.6.64: Can you read all of Hoover's notes? I think I can make out Gutzman, who then was in Justice, I think press office, now L.A. Times. They not only have Buchanan listed as Internal Security- C, but the record was also routed to CCBV. CONFIDENTIAL.

55: serial 2632- note they were careful to omit how long it took to reassemble the rifle.

Note your notations of their files seems to be wrong. You omit part of the main file number. You have this as 62-2632. There is another part of the main file number after 62, like 109090 or 109060; the the number 2632, which is the serial within each file.

59- can you read all of Hoover's notes at the end?

69 - on such as Zapruder film. Naturally there was no point to the FBI in using the 2 film as a time clock and they saw no point in the Commission's wanting to know where the car was with each shot.

70 uses this matter is on the Director's 'Special list.' I do not recall overseeing this before. It could be important in FOIA work if you see any more, to establish places not searched.

71-Can you make out Hoover's notes?

76 is quite important to us in the spectro case in any way. I have already discussed this with \*in. It says there are more pages but you sent the first only. This says there was a resubmission to the Lab and gives some results. Have you any knowledge of any such lab reports or any prior knowledge of any resubmission? Is it 48 the shell that had been only in this rifle? All had been chambered before. It is in RIK, I think but I am not taking time to check now.

It is my belief, which may be wrong, that some of this material should have been provided in response to the original requests, other under discovery. I have no clear recollection of what we asked for under discovery now. Probably \*in does.
