K275 Test bullet and cartridge case from a .380 Auto Remington automatic pistol, Serial Number PA 18949

Results of examination:

The bullet which was previously submitted by the Atlanta Office as having been removed from the body of consisted of a portion of the lead core from a metal jacketed bullet. No barrel markings of the type necessary for identification of the weapon from which this bullet was fired are present on this bullet. Therefore, no comparison between this bullet and the test bullet in K275 is possible.

There are no specimens in the National Unidentified Ammunition File which could have been fired from the same weapon as the test bullet and cartridge case, K275.

No previous record of the weapon represented by K275 was located in the National Stolen Property Index or the National Crime Information Center.

Specimen K275 is being returned to Atlanta herewith.

Results of emanication:

Of through QS, were found to vary in composition even though they were all from the same manufacturer.

The core portion of the QS4 bullet fragment from the Victim's body is similar in composition to the lead core of the bullet in the cartridge designated Q4 and could have come from a source such as represented by the lead core of the bullet in Q4.

The bullet jacket portion of specimen Q64 is similar in composition to the motal of the jackets of the bullets in the Q4 through Q8 cartridges and could have come from the source represented by these bullets.

Result of examination:

Q377 was examined for watermarks and indented writing with negative results. The hand printed word "CETERFICATE" appears on the cover of this pad. Although a number of hand printing similarities were noted in this word when compared with Ray's hand printing indicating it was possibly prepared by the subject, the limited nature of this hand printing precludes a definite identification of Ray as the author of this hand printing.

No visible or invisible laundry marks were found on specimens Q373 through Q332.

Specimen Q383 is a men's 17-jewel Witthauer wrist watch encased in a Witthauer watchcase. Both the watchcase and the movement are of Swiss origin. The wrist watch movement does not bear a serial number and there is no physical evidence that the movement has been repaired since there are no jewelers' "scratch marks" inscribed on the inside of the case. The watchcase bears two sets of numbers, one above the other, as follows: 8001

The Vittnauer factory should be able to advise as to the significance, if any, of these markings. The possibility of tracing the retail sale of specimen Q383 appears remote. No foreign material was located on or in the watch which could assist in tracing the wrist watch.

The wrist watch has a stainless steel expansiontype band bearing the markings "ADMIRAL U.S.A" There is an Admiral Watch Band Company, Incorporated, 9 IDebrosses Street, New York City, which manufactures: watch bands.

The test bullets and cartridge cases from the .38 Special caliber "Liberty Chief" revolver, serial number 715 were compared with all similar specimens to the National Unidentified Amounitiess File without effecting on identification.

Two latest fingerprints of value were developed on Q384 but they were not identical with the fingerprints of JAMES EARL RAY. The questioned handwriting and hand printing on Q384 were not prepared by JAMES EARL RAY. K486 has been previously forwarded to Legat, Ottawa. Q377 through Q384 have been previously forwarded to Legat, London.
