

JFK's assassination due to conspiracy

The Warren Commission investigated the Kennedy assassination and issued 26 volumes of information, concluding that Lee Harvey Oswald killed President Kennedy. Not so, say the vast majority of authors of 30 books and hundreds of articles. They say the assassination was a conspiracy, that Oswald was not the lone killer.

The most convincing author regarding the conspiracy is Harold Weisberg, who has written eight books on the subject, including "Case Open" and "Never Again." Mr. Weisberg is a native of Wilmington, a former reporter for the defunct Morning News and an OSS agent (Office of Strategic Services) during World War II.

I am convinced the assassination was a conspiracy. Hood College in Frederick, Md., is now the repository of Mr. Weisberg's research documents on the assassination.
