In previous memos I referred to representation of Hepburn and the book by the "Sutto" law firm in Montreal. I have now learned the full neme (above) and the address. That is Room 700, 60 James St., West. Sutto apparently handles the Tara business in the firm. A Miss Pueso there (fluent English, French accent) knows about the book. She told my source that they "were held up 'at the bost', some sort of trouble getting the books out of bond". As of two weeks ago, she said, distribution hed begun. Also, local destribution, in Montreal. Tara is not handling "L'Amerigue Brule", the French edition. Thet, in Montreal, is by another firm, name not learned.

There is neither a phone-book listing nor en information number on Tars. That was the name of the Scarlet C'Hare family estate in "Gone With the Wind", if there is significance. Indications are Tars is for this purpose only.

Lemerre seems to be visiting US regularly. The New York Times 1/1/69 story has been syndicated. It appears in the "Globe and Mail" in Canada.

Recent information from those directly involved asems too self-serving for uncorroborsted acceptability.
