Mark Lane has practiced criminal law in New York for more than 15 years. In 1960, Mr. Lane, together with Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt, Senator Hatch, Lehman, and others, founded the National Democratic Movement within the New York Democratic Party. Following the Kennedy assassination, Mr. Lane formed the Citizens' Committee of Inquiry, which became an investigation into the facts surrounding the assassination and the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald. He personally traveled to Dallas several times, testified twice before the Warren Commission, and has lectured widely on his findings throughout the United States and Europe.
