Dallas, Nov. 22 (AP)-President Kennedy and Gov. John Connally of Texas were shot from ambush today.

ent Kennedy died at 1 p.m. (CST).

Kennedy apparently was shot in the head. He fell face down in the back seat of his car. Blood was on his head. Mrs Kennedy cried, "Oh, no!" and tried to hold his

The shooting took place about 1:40 p.m., New York time, as the President's limousine came out of an underpass in the highway on the way to the Dallas Freeway. The shots apparently came from a grassy knoll in the area, for motorcycle police immediately raced there. There was no word what has happened to the assassin.

Connaily, remained half seated, slumped to the left. There was blood on his face and forehead.

The President and the Governor were rushed to Park land Hospital near the Dallas Trade Mart, where K. was to have made a speech.

Dallas police said the President was apparently shot by a gunman with a .30 caliber rifle.

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover telephoned the Dallas FBI office and ordered an all-out investigation of the attempt on the lives of the President and Connally.

Police have a description of the suspect, which they would not reveal. They rushed every available officer to seal off the area near the County continues. More than 300 policemen were involved in the manhunt.

The President was reportedly hit three times, t in the upper chest.

It was reported that sheriff's deputies had picked up a young man and were questioning him behind closed doors. No further information was available.

Police believed he had fired on the Presidential party

AP Photographer James W. Altgens said he saw blood on the President's head.

Altgens said he heard two shots but thought someone was shooting fireworks until he saw the blood on the President.

Altgens said he saw no one with a gun.

There was an unconfirmed report that Vice President don Johnson had been wounded slightly. One spectator said he saw Johnson walk into the hospital holding his arm.

Two Roman Catholic priests were summoned to the emergency room where the 46-year-old President lay.

The President was given the last rites of the Roman

Pandemonium broke loose around the scene.

The secret service waved the motorcade on at top speed to the hospital.

Even at high speed, it took nearly five minutes to the car to the ambulance entrance of the hospital. Reporters saw Kennedy lying flat on his face near

Three shots rang out as Kennedy and Connoily drove from Dallas Airport, open car. President's head bloodied. He slumped into Mrs. Kennedy's arms. She cradled him, crying, "Oh No."

Bell said a man and a woman were scrambling on the upper level of a walkway overlooking the underpass.

The President's mother and father, Mr. and Mrs. Joseph P. Kennedy, have been notified of the shooting. Joseph Kennedy is recovering from a stroke suffered over a year ago.
