Suit Accuses NBC Of Rejecting Ads

NEW YORK, Nov. 7 (AP)—The National Broadcasting Co. was sued today for \$1.5 million for allegedly breaching a contract to show spot commercials for a film about the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

National General Pictures, Inc., distributors of the movie "Executive Action," which fictionalizes the planning, execution and aftermath of the assassination, contended that the network abrogated an Oct. 12 agreement "allegedly because of the controversial nature of the film."
