NEW FILMS HOW THREE SNIPERS SHOT THE PRESIDENT

WHO KILLED President Kennedy? Lee Harvey Oswald, acting on his own. That was the conclusion of the U.S. Government's official investigation, the Warren Report. Not so, says a new Hollywood film, EXECUTIVE ACTION (Odeon, Leicester Square, "A," 91 minutes).

ACTION (Odeon, Leicester It suggests that three snipers gunned down the President in Dallas, on November 22, 1963; that they were part of a con-spiracy hatched by a group of Right-wing Americans; and that Oswald, who was arrested then murdered by club-owner Jack Ruby, was no more than a scapegoat deliberately selected by the plotters because of his cryptic, Left-wing back-ground. ground.

ground. Using newsreel and TV films of the time, reconstructions of factual events, and purely fictional scenes, the film pro-ceeds like this :-Burt Lancaster and Robert Ryan play two of a small group of "powerful" Ameri-cans (their actual status is left vague) who meet to plot the assassination.

Disastrous

Their motive? They believe that the President's liberal policies — pro-Negro, pro-Test Ban treaty with Russia, pro-pull out from Vietnam—will be disastrous for America. And they resent the exclu-sive power of the Kennedy family, which seems to have sewn up the presidency for the foreseeable future, with two terms likely for John, two for Robert, and then two for Edward. Three sharp-shooters are

Edward. Three sharp-shooters are selected for the job and are rigorously trained as a team to hit a dummy moving target in the desert. Their allegiance is assured: firstly, all were involved in the Bay of Pigs invasion of Cuba and blame the President for its ignominous failure. Secondly, each is assured swift passage out of America, a new identity with matching passport, 25,000 dollars a year for five years, and then a

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further 100,000 dollars in a secret Swiss bank account. Next, a double for the real Oswald is recruited, coached in his voice and mannerisms, and then set to lay a trail of incriminating evidence that the Press to the real Oswald immediately after the murder.
