## Accuser Accused

An investigator for the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office said last week that his department was considering the filing of criminal charges against Mark Lane, the well-known assassination investigator, conspiracy allegator and attorney. The investigation, a department spokesman said, had to do with allegations that Mr. Lane had accepted \$7,500 from an officer of the People's Temple, the Rev. Jim Jones's suicide cult, after saying that he needed it to buy an unpublished article damaging to the church. In fact, it has been alleged, Mr. Lane already had the article. Mr. Lane did not immediately comment on the possible charge of grand theft.
