## Lane Says He Will Sue Government, Reporters

DURHAM, N.H. (AP) — Former People's Temple lawyer Mark Lane says he will file a multimillion-dollar suit against the Federal Government and reporters for publishing what he says is false information about him.

The activist lawyer, who was in Guyana when Rep. Leo J. Ryan (D-Calif.), three newsmen and a Temple defector were gunned down in November, announced his plan to a student audience yesterday at the University of New Hampshire.

He also said he has a Central Intelligence Agency memorandum dated 1966 which he said details an international effort to discredit him.

Lane will file the suit in the near future against the CIA, the Department of Justice, "and their lackeys at The New York Times, CBS, Time magazine, Newsweek and everyone else who has been publishing false information," he said.

"Every word that's been published by the media is a distortion or a flat, outright lie and we have waited long enough to take action," he told a group of about 900.

He was paid \$2400, plus expenses, by the Memorial University Student Organization, for his speech.
