Profile indicted For Gun Possession

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., May 9 (UPI)—A former southern Illinois leader of the right-wing Minutemen, arrested in a raid that yielded 591 machine guns and submachine guns in April, was indicted by a federal grand jury Thursday.

Richard Lauchli, Jr., 42, was charged with 17 counts of violating the Federal Gun Control Act, including illegal possession and sale of firearms, possession of firearms by a convicted felon and failing to register and pay a tax as an interstate dealer in firearms.
