Hitler, who went on to promise . . . 'elect us and we shall restore law and order. We shall by law and order be respected among the nations of the world.' . . . And if you think Germany started the war, wrong again. France, Britain, Russia and the United States could have stopped Germany before the shooting began. Why didn't they?"
