JACK LAWRENCE, residing at YMCA, Ervay Street, Dallas, Texas, Downtown Lincoln-Mercury, Commerce at Industrial, telephone RI 8-0611, at 11 AM, 11/23/63, advised SA KUYKENDALL telephonically that OSWALD was in that establishment about week ago and spoke to employees, AL BOGARD and FRANK PIZZO (sales Manager) about wanting to buy an automdile. OSWALD allegedly told one of these men that he had no money then but "in a couple of weeks" he would have money to buy a car for cash.

Agent inquired of LAWRENCE for home addresses of BOGARD and PIZZO in order that they could be later interviewed. He attempted to secure their home addresses. They advised LAWRENCE that they would speak for themselves. He was unable to obtain from them their addresses. He said they would be working today until 9 PM. LAWRENCE said they knew OSWALD as a customer and have his name written down.
