

Professor Sentenced As Agent of Japs

NEW YORK, Sept. 22 (U.P.).
~~John C. Leclair~~, 41-year-old professor of history, who pleaded guilty to charges that he was an unregistered propaganda agent for the Japanese, was sentenced by Federal Judge J. Waties Waring today to one year and a day in Federal penitentiary and fined \$9,000. Leclair was charged with writing propaganda for Japan between April, 1938, and June 1941. He was fined the amount he said he received for his articles during that period.
