Mr. HITCHT KELLT our interviewed at 2608 nightand Avenue and Turnel a following information.

Mr. EELLY advised that he has been employed as a cook for Mr. PETEL CHAPPEL for the past neveral years and was as employed many to the REEL occupied the present house, 2668 fluctioned Svenue.

After being advised of the nature of the interview, he stated that he resenters LTEC CALT only variety. He remembers that he occupied Boom 14 for about two menths chartly after they first moved into that house. He said that he serves breakfast to the boarders between 6 and 7:30 every norming and that this individual in Boom 14 came out of his room at approximately 7:15 or 7:20 after everyone else had finished breakfast and gone to work, had his breakfast and then went back to bed. KELLY addiced that he recalls "fuscing" at this man several times for waiting so late to have his breakfast.

FELLY stated that he recalled something peculiar about this man in that he paid for room and board each week he was there, except the last week, he only paid for a took and did not take any meals. He said that he recalls this individual stating that the recann he did not have reals was that he did not have any money.

KELLY views' a composite drawing and craved that it resembled of he, except that he helioved CALY to be thinner in the fice than this drawing indicated.

KELLY he described as a Negro male, approximately 50 years old.
