CHARLES STEPHENS, cab driver, United Cab Company, 255 Forsyth Street, Atlanta, Georgia, was exhibited a group of photographs which included the two photographs of ERIC STARVO GALT. STEPHENS stated that none of the individuals depicted in the photographs resembled the passenger that he transported on April 5, 1968, at approximately 8:41 a.m. from the vicinity of Capitol Avenue and Memorial Drive to the Greyhound Bus Depot in Atlanta. STEPHENS stated that the thing he remembered about the passenger he had in his cab was the fact that he had a very lean, thin face and none of the individuals in the above-mentioned photographs displayed such facial characteristics.
