On April 12, 1968, MRS. LUCY PINELA, Manager, Home Service Laundry and Dry Cleaning, 5200 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, was shown composite photographs of the subject from both Birmingham and Memphis. PINELA advised that the photograph from Memphis most nearly resembles a MR. E. GALT, a customer of the laundry. She advised that it is a good resemblance to GALT from the nose to the top of the head, however, the lower part from the mouth to the chin does not too closely GALT's. She further advised that the lower part of the photograph from Birmingham around the chin most closely resembles the lower facial structure of customer GALT. ~~She further advised that the lower part of the photograph from Birmingham around the chin most closely resembles the lower facial structure of customer GALT.~~ Prior to viewing the composite photographs, PINELA had ~~previously~~ advised that customer GALT usually brought shirts to the laundry for washing which had extra wide collar points. Upon viewing the photograph from Birmingham, she advised that the collar in that photograph closely resembles the type worn by GALT.
