SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, NOVEMBER

22, 1963

At approximately 6:10PM, today JESSE CORE, Owner, JESSE CORE & CO. PUBLIC RELATIONS firm, advised he had been talking with a friend who reminded him that the name of LEE OSWALD was believed to be identical with one of two persons passing out handbills in front of the TradeMart in New Orleans during the sugmer, 1963, for the Fair Play For Cuba Committee.

At approximately 6:30PM, CORE again telephonically contacted this office and addised he had just talked with JOHN CBRPORAN, News Director for Station WDSU who advised him that they had sent a film and taped interview of OSWALD to New York to be used on a national MBC newscast or telecast.
