## High Court Upsets Louisiana Red Curl

WASHINGTON, April 26-The Supreme Court declared unconstitutional today major provisions of Louisiana's subversive activities and Communist-control law.

It also held that Federai courts may enjoin state court criminal proceedings under statutes that unconstitutionally threatened to deny citizens freedom of speech.

The decision overruled a

previous doctrine under which Federal courts had abstained from enjoining state criminal proceedings to give the state courts an opportunity to rule upon the laws themselves.

It also outflanked a Federal law of 1958 that limited the Court's power to enjoin state proceedings. Today, the Court held that, since the petitioners had been arrested
