

THOMAS W. LENEHAN

Supervisor, 44, In FBI Records **Division Here**

Thomas W. Lenehan, 44, a special agent of the FBI since 1962 and a supervisor at its records division, died at Fairfax Hospital Monday following a heart attack.

Mr. Lenehan was born in Webster, Mass., and graduated from Holy Cross College. He earned a law degree at Georgetwon University and then served as an officer in the Marine Corps until 1962.

He entered the FBI as a special agent that year and served in the Minneapolis and Los Angeles divisions. He was transferred to FBI headquarters here in 1975. He was a supervisor in the Freedom of Information-Privacy Act section of the records management division.

Mr. Lenehan's survivors include his wife, Ann, and four children, Sean, Mary, Katherine and Susan, all of the home in Fairfax; his mother, Bernadette Lenehan, of Webster, Mass., and two brothers, Stuart, of Webster, and

Leland, of Detroit.
