After phoning you about Jimmy's letter I got back to the four envelopes. At this point, supper time (and we have company coming) I'm half way through second, to the 8/9/68 Ray letter to Battle. I've done what I said I couldn't take time for but feel I have to. Or, about 3,000 words to now! My reasons are to be sure that nothing is missed and because I have seen what you may or may not have but didn't tell me you did in those two fantastic huge letters to Ray. I have made detailed notes on them, less detailed on other things. I think these require changes in what you have written and there can be no compromise without jeopardizing Ray's rights. The amount of overkill to now is irrelevant.

This does not mean that you have to do it. But I am convinced that treating this as a mere appendix is not acceptable. It relates to almost every argument we make, confirms much and indicts everyone, including the judge and all lawyers. It is fantastic. Thank God for his unspeakable ego!

I write this in the event any of the company goes back into town tonight so it can reach you Monday. I don't think there should be ANY final typing until we can go over this.
