Frier to the printing of the book, in the thought that you kight want some copies to go to Kambers, I told Jis to tell you that I would let you have copies for this purpose at what comes to less them my actual cost. This I intended for Hembers only. As with MAIN, shen it would have helped us all for Members to have copies (and despite their not having been given them have node extensive use of it). In all other dealings I much be completed of the basis for legitimate completet. When I have time 1'll probably send a couple of copies to Members . Several have sent people have and bought copies in advance. It thus would be usateful/to send them added copies. But soong "edition" many of when I do not describe this way I much have but one policy. If I do not some will have legitimate basis for personal complaint.

Iou will remander that with Francesp I bought and gave quite a few copies to Sembars. It does not bother me that not one thought the copy was from me and not ope sent me even's pro forms note of thanks. "I does bother me that not one made any use of any kind, not one had any further inquiry, gad that limited as my means are this was a very poor investment for me.

However, I am propared to sail to any Hember you may went any copies you may went and at the premised discount. I'll sail any others you may went sont for you at the regular price all others are paying, if you want any. Criticis who want copies may obtain them from me or as happened with WeIV by a variety of ambidden subterfuges.

While I's happy for you that you have no financial problems of this kind to contend with paying for the printing of this book alone, made possible by maringing and doing without while I accumulated enough to reprint two other books about to go out of print, is cleaning me out at a time when I may face serious medical emergencies. I have to keep this in midf, if I hope it does not eventuate, and I have to try to prepare for the reprinting of those books about to go out of print.

Some of the critics, on learning of the book, wrote and ordered it. While I've been resting with my feet up I've also been licking thousands of stamps to go on a mulling that is now completed and will go out today, as will the first of the conies I have been able to package. Levey at first fefused to identify himself except by name. Lil made as she recalls about three fiforts before I was on the phone. I asked him the same question, not knowing she had.

He claimed to be working for CCI and yet to be independenter of Lane. I know I have to have been skeptical of that. I assume that I indicated this and my belief that there is nothing in CCI not intended to promote Lane.

Lil's recollection and impression is that Levey was needlessly mysterious and evasive for the period of time she was on the phone, which is only until a little after I did. This is entirely consistent with his refusal to respond when I tried to learn what he might be trying to do so I might be able to help or direct him.
