Dear Mr. Shea,

There is an exceptionally provocative document in the newest batch of AG and DAG King records. AG # 2 states that there "is a question whether Lovison (sic) himself is an FBI informant." The FBI denies this flatly. No record that I have been provided, from any source, reflects the basis for this question being in anyone's mind. I do not recall any record that indicates the possibility Lovison was an informer. However, there should be some reason for Jack Fuller having recorded this in a memo to files. I hope that there is a search for any such records.

Several of the records have notations indicating the existence of files that appear to be pertinent. For example, LHR # 1, Title FBI - KING Documents."

LHR # 10 has the notation, "See OPR 10/1, 10/13/76. This is from the AG to the FBI Director. It refers to documents I'd like to know that I have or will have.

LHR # 1 refers to attached material that is not attached. If this attached material was withheld under an exemption I'd like to be able to indicate it with this record.

I recognize that there can be some problems from these records not having been provided with those I received earlier and from the fact that some have not yet been processed.
