FRANK CAMILLA LIBERTO, home address 3271 Powers Street, Raleight Memphis, Tennessee, caployed an president of the LL & L Produce Company, S14 Scott, Memphis, was interviewed at his place of business and he furnished the following information;

To the best of his knowledge, he was at his place of business on April 4, 1968, and stated he did not recall exactly what time he arrived but remembered linving at any time between 4:15 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. He called his wift at home just prior to leaving and she could probably verify th. fact he arrived home sometime after 5:00 p.m.

LIELATO emphatically denied having they introduced the identity of the person responsible for Dr. Electronically KING, JR.'s death on April 4, 1968. Is also emphatically denied ever discussing with anyone the possibility of shooting KING although he admitted he had made the usual deregatory remarks about KING's action in Memphis, Tennessee, and also about the fact KING was partly responsible for the curiew imposed on the city of Memphis resulting in loss of revenue by his business establishment in the Memphis area. He advised he may have made statements to the effect that KING should be may have business not recall any specific statements made by him to this effect. He stated that because of the curfew, he suffered approximately \$40,000 in lost sales at the produce company.

LIBERTO stated he frequently makes trips to New Orleans, Louisiana, to get strawberries and other produce and also because members of his family reside in the New Orleans area. He stated most of the co-workers, employees, and customers at his produce company know of his travels to New Orleans insemuch as he frequently mentions his trips to New Orleans.

LIBERTO stated that regarding telephone calls allogedly made by him or telephone calls to him on April 4, 1968, he specifically denied receiving any call where montion was made of Dr. KING or of Dr. KING's shooting. LIBERTO stated most of his produce is purchased through telephone conversations and this

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inevitably involves talking about large 14... of money over the telephone. He advised he did not receive may telephone 'call on April 4, 1968, regarding NDG and other the would have remembered any conversation over the telephone of in person which allegedly took place on April 4, 1968, involving the death of KING. He further stated he would have no reason for being involved in any action of this pert.

LIBERTO advised he frequently trusts various individuals regarding racial matters and may have made disparaging remarks to some of his customers involving KING but reiterated he does not consider this uncommon among various co-workers at his place of employeet.

LIDENTO adviced he had had no individual analysis recently in late fall or early winter at his profides terminy fitting the description of the unknown individual description at having long straight, coarse, block hair, "jungle rat" on his neck, clender build, drop shoulders, tan complexion, 5'10"-5'11", 160 pounds, and "not a day over 25" year. of age. He always employs Negro males for help in the proceed department and any unidentified white male form in or special his produce company would most likely be a truck driver or an individual who had come to his establishment to purchase produce.

LIBERTO stated he left work between 4:15 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. and was not avare of MING's death uncll after his arrival at his home. He advised the first he heard of MING's death was from his wife or from the news madic which reported it on television.

LIBERNO was shown photograph of Julies Thill will, find known as ERIC STARVO GALT and he stated he had never seen this individual before. He was furniched other alianes used by TAY and stated he had never heard any of these names used in his presence. He then made a search of his records but could locate no record on any individual by the name of JAMUS EARL RAY, ERIC STARVO GALT, HARVEY LOUMEYER, or JOHN WILLARD as ever being employed at his establishment.
