Students Dig Into Kennedy Death Story

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 20
Nagging doubts about the
Warren Commission report on
the assassination of President
John F. Kennedy are being
explored in a massive study at
the University of California at
Los Angeles.

Directing the project is Law
Professor Wesley J. Liebeler,
who served as an assistant
counsel on the Commission
staff. Twenty law students are
participating.

Results will serve as the
basis for part of a book
planned by Liebeler.

Liebeler says the study was
spawned by two books critical
of the Warren Report—"Rush
to Judgment" and "Inquest."

Although Liebeler himself
has been critical of some of
the things done by the Com-
mission staff, he is thoroughly
in accord with the Commis-
sion findings.
