Lounge Owner Sues Time Inc.

Charging the Sept. 8 issue of Life Magazine caused scandalous publicity for his Speakeasy Lounge at 834 N. Rampart, Glenn Slayton Wednesday filed a \$10,000 suit against Time Inc.

The suit said on page 95 of the magazine, three pictures were explained by captions saying, "Marcello's interests include sports betting parlors such as the Bank Club (above), the Speakeasy restaurant - casino (below, left), and the Sho-Bar, a strip joint in New Orleans."

Slayton said he is the only owner of the Speakeasy, and has never operated any gambling or betting devices there since he opened it Dec. 28, 1965.
