## Jury Checks Capital Phone Call Records

BATON ROUGE, La. (AP)— The East Baton Rouge Parish grand jury, which is investigating organized crime, yesterday looked over telephone call records from the office of Gov. John J. McKeithen and then recessed until tomorrow.

The records were subpensed from the State Division of Administration.

Aubrey Young, a former aide to McKeithen, has testified in the grand jury probe about calls he received from Carlos Marcello, Gretna rackets figure.

Life magazine has claimed up to 60 calls might have been made between the governor's office and the office of Marcello in a Jefferson Parish motel.

The grand jury had indicted D'Alton Smith, New Orleans contractor, for public bribery in an alleged \$25,000 offer to Young.
