Interview with William H. Lindsay 1:30 p.m. 11/5/68

As you requested, I interviewed Lindsay, nee at his home, 719 Dumaine, but at the Baldwin-west Real Estate Co., at 824 Royal. His phones are 524-6247 (home) and 522-9228.

Contrary to what you seem to have been told, he says he knows little about Clay Shaw. He acted as a broker only, and that 8 years ago, before Shaw's retirement. Involved were two Burgundy St. properties, valued at \$45,000 and \$407,000, neither of which Lindsay sold.

He also has recollections of properties on Toulouse and Gov. Williams. One of both of these Shaw handled himself.

Lindsay recommends speak to William H. Horton, 3315 de Sota, 488-9372, retired contractor who did all of Shaw's restorations. He describes Horton as the best of the restorers, in the quarter.

He asked not to be connected with it but encouraged speaking to Mr. F.M. Blackshears, ~~623 Sugarman~~ block of Royal, where Lindsay had a desk 8 years ago. 522-1317 Blackshears and Kernhaus. He describes her as well acquainted with Shaw.

One of these properties was jointly owned with Mario Bermudez. He and Shaw were there together when Lindsay saw them.

Naturally, he also recommended speaking to Jeff Bidderson.
