Dear Mr. Rankin:

On July 29, 1964, Mr. Aubrey Ray Lindsey, Richardson, Texas, advised Special Agents of our Dallas Office that a business acquaintance, one Malcolm J. Hoy, told him on November 22, 1963, he saw the President Kennedy motorcade. Hoy advised Lindsey President Kennedy had been shot twice "because he was there watching it." Mr. Lindsey thought this remark was unusual and added he did not know Hoy's present location. Mr. Lindsey said Hoy formerly worked at the General Motors plant in Arlington, Texas.

Investigation at Arlington, Texas, determined inquiries had been received concerning Hoy from the General Motors plant at South Gate, California.

Enclosed for your information are two copies of the report of Special Agent Robert H. Karl dated August 24, 1964, at Los Angeles, California, captioned "Lee Harvey Oswald, Internal Security - R - Cuba." It contains the results of an interview with Mr. Hoy.

No further action is being taken in this matter.
