Dear Chris,

I am answering your letter of 8/13 via Gary so he can know what I've said and add anything he might want. I am really pressed for time so cannot respond at length.

I am satisfied there was no actual broadcast of the motorcade at the crucial moment, among the reasons being the apparent official establishment of the fake character of one in the possession, I believe, of UPI. It seems to have been made by a Dallas radio person, not to be genuine. There was a time when that pig Larry Schiller thought he had an actual tape recording of the events. His failure to use it persuades me even he dared not. He told me about it in 12/66. I have the Commission's file on this, complete with Bell Labs' opinion of the sounds, indicative of more than three shots.

On the Sunday Times' Insight article of Oct 9/66, I have a friend there. I'll ask him for it when I see him again. If it is of worth, I'll distribute. The prospects are they have nothing new. At that time there was much turmoil. I know the Daily Times staff at that period ordered some documents from the Archives, but I've never remembered to ask them what they got....Paris-Match: thanks. I'll send anything of interest to Gary, others....Don't go to any expense of Ray extradition hearing. I've more than enough without it. I just wanted a more complete file for history if it were convenient. Watch current papers, however, for recently an AP story appeared in Stars and Stripes when it was not in the major US papers.
