Is there live coverage of the assassination on the radio? If so, is there not the possibility that a sound recording exists? I know you said you found no sound recording but I'm not sure if you know of this radio coverage. There is no recording exists if it does not there not be one elsewhere - the broadcast test stands out as it probably passed through some sort of booster for European transmission - so might not a tape recording exist? I would like to know what you think - correct me if I'm wrong - the radio coverage of the assassination - I was unsure up till now as to whether there was radio coverage or not.

Dear Harold

This is just a short note concerning magazines etc. I have just written to Schoener and in mentioning copies of Faris Match I remembered two other things that I thought might be of interest; although they in fact contain little if anything new to you I just thought I'd mention them. First is the Sunday Times magazine of Oct. 9 1966 which contains the article "Insight: ~~The Kennedy~~" President Kennedy's family against the Commission's report. It is almost unavailable now but the bookseller friend in Fifebridge located a copy but since I already have a copy and it would have cost over £2 I did not buy it.

Second is the Jackdaw Special "The Assassination of President Kennedy" which was published over here to coincide with the paperback edition of "Rush to Judgement". It too is a summary of the evidence against the Report, it includes a copy of the full Alteens photo, life-size drawing of 62766 rifle, Autopsy face-sheet, autopsy report page 6, Comm. Exhib. 385, and several other things including a carboard cut-out of Dealey Plaza. I don't know if you are already aware of these - or even if they are of interest (since they certain little if anything that will be new to you).

Regarding Faris Match, if my friend in Fifebridge is unable to locate ~~F~~ copies I will send you my copies since I am sure they will be more useful in your possession than in mine.

I look forward to reading your new book in due course. Regarding Gary Schoener says it is very good. Regarding photocopies of James Earl Ray extradition hearings newspaper reports, two years ago I wrote to several papers regarding photocopies, the rates varies from paper to paper; Daily Mail 6/- per page, Daily Express and Daily Mirror 10/6 per page, Sunday Times 15/- per page are the charges. I know of and that was two years ago. Again I don't know if this information is relevant or useful to you. And I thought I'd mention it.
