DEAR HAROLD,

I ENCLOSE COPIES OF MY LETTER TO DR. G. T. MANN AND HIS FIRST REPLY TO ME — HE HAS SINCE REPLIED FURTHER SAYING HE ~~HE~~ CAN ADD NOTHING WITHOUT INFORMATION AND EXPERIMENTATION WHICH IS BEYOND HIM. ANYWAY I WOULD LIKE TO HEAR WHAT YOU THINK OF DR. MANN'S OPINION.

WITH REGARD TO MY LETTER TO HIM — I SAID THERE WAS NO BULLET IN THE WOUND BECAUSE THE OBJECT OF THE LETTER WAS ASCERTAIN IF IT WAS POSSIBLE FOR A ROSE STEM TO INFLECT THE DAMAGE, MENTION OF METAL IN THE NECK AND THE SHOULDER WOUND WOULD HAVE CLOUDED THE ISSUE. ALL THE DAMAGE THAT I MENTION IS TAKEN FROM THE MEDICAL REPORTS AND DOCTORS' EVIDENCE IN 26 VOLS.

DR. MANN SEEMS TO VIEW MY THEORY AS A POSSIBILITY, AT LEAST. THE ONLY OTHER REPLY I HAVE SO FAR RECEIVED WAS FROM DR. CYRIL WECHT — HE REALIZED MY LETTER RELATED TO THE JFK ASSASS. ; HIS OPINION WAS THAT THE INTERNAL DAMAGE INFLECTED WAS SUCH THAT IT PRECLUDED THE POSSIBILITY OF A ROSE STEM INFLECTING IT.

ANYWAY, I WOULD LIKE TO HEAR WHAT YOU NOW HAVE TO SAY ON THIS IN THE LIGHT OF DR. MANN'S OPINION. I LOOK FORWARD TO HEARING FROM YOU IN THE NEAR FUTURE.
