Attached 105-62555-4225 has a less than legible marginal note partly climinated by lopeded meroring. It appears to include the word "tickler." If this is so than it is established that there is a tickler that has not been provided. In that its fact its existence appears to be a secret, as my prior appeals show.

With the history of the so-called long tickler in mind I fear that any delay will result in its destruction.

This record is one of a number establishing the fact that there is no chain of possession on the basic evidence of the crime. This is important information and would be important in a tickler. So would all other information like it. It would be a great loss if there should be anyther such destruction of irreplaceable evidence.

I have already provided themenes and functions of many supervisors at FMISQ who may have kept the ticklers for the various divinions. I have appealed the failure to search those Divinions and this should include any ticklers. (Note "C/Rocce" at the bettem. Richard D. Rocce was a case supervisor, also described as "case agent," in the Criminal Section of the General Investigative Division. He also should have kept a tickler.)

In the Demestic Intelligence Divinion the supervisor to show the case was assigned was Robert E. Lominan. That he drafted directives for the field effices in the name of the Director in illustrated by attached 62-109050-5074.
