HARVEY CASH, American Consul, Nuevo Laredo, Mexico, advised that he had verified that GILBERTO LOPEZ, Passport No. 310162, Mexican Tourist Permit No. M-6-2-554, had entered Mexico at Nuevo Laredo, Mexico, on November 23, 1963, en route to Mexico City.

CASH stated that GILBERTO CASARON GARZA, Chief of Mexican Immigration, had advised that LOPEZ entered Mexico by automobile and had traveled to Mexico City. LOPEZ was listed in Mexican Immigration files as being from Tampa, Florida.

On December 4, 1963, SA T-1 advised that he had received information that one GILBERTO LOPEZ, American, 23 years of age, with North American Passport # 310162, dated July 13, 1960, entered Mexico at Nuevo Laredo, Mexico, on November 23, 1963. LOPEZ was issued Mexican Tourist Permit M 8-24553 and his destination was reflected as Mexico, D. F. On November 27, 1963, LOPEZ departed Mexico, D. F., by special airplane for Havana, Cuba.
