Investigation failed to establish that Lorenz as a victim in the Walte Slave Trailie Act case.

Articles appearing in the "Washington Star" dated June 14, 1976, and in the "how York Daily News" on June 13, 1976, and June 14, 1976, allege that Marita Lorenz lived with Fidel Castro in Havana in 1959 and was later recruited by the Control Intelligence Agency (CIA) to poison Castro. According to the articles, she was contacted by Frank Fiorini, also known as Frank Sturgis, and by Alex Borks, both alleged to be employed by the Cla. She was urged to travel to Cuba for the purpose of killing Castro and she finally agreed to do so. She told reporters that Fiorini furnished her with poison which she was to sprinkle into Castro's coffee. The poison, which was contained in two capsules, was bidden in Lorenz's cold cream jar, but when one reached Havana and attoupted to remove the capuales, she discovered that the capsules bad dissolved, and rendered the poison mealers. AM
