JOSEPH LOUW, NEW YORK CITY, INTERVIEWED AND ADVISED HE TOOK NINE ZERO TO ONE ZERO ZERO PHOTOGRAPHS AT MEMPHIS ON DATE OF ASSASSINATION. SEVERAL OF THESE PHOTOGRAPHS APPEAR IN APRIL ONE TWO, SIXTY-EIGHT ISSUE LIFE MAGAZINE. HE FURTHER STATED THAT HE DEVELOPED FILM AT PHOTOGRPHY SHOP OF ERNEST WITHERS, BEALE STREET, MEMPHIS. WHEN HE ENTERED SHOP APPROXIMATELY ONE HOUR AFTER ASSASSINTION, WITHERS WAS ON TELEPHONE TO EITHER POLICE OR FBI ADVISING THEM THAT ONE RAYMOND ALEXANDER (PHONETIC) HAD BEEN IN HIS SHOP ON DATE OF ASSASSINATION, FOR APPROXIMTELY TWO HOURS.
