

Senator Holman Weds Mrs. Ernest Lundeen

MINNEAPOLIS, July 5.—Senator Holman of Oregon today announced his marriage here in a quiet ceremony to Mrs. Ernest Lundeen, widow of Senator Lundeen of Minnesota.

Earlier reports had said they were to be married at the Minneapolis courthouse today. Instead the ceremony took place last night at the home of Judge and Mrs. Levi M. Hall, a Hennepin County district judge.

Present at the wedding were Judge and Mrs. Hall and Mrs. Lundeen's two children, Lt. Ernest Lundeen, 22, home on furlough from the Army, and Joan, 20, a student at the University of Minnesota.

In a statement announcing the ceremony, Senator Holman said he and his bride "plan to proceed at once to Oregon by automobile which will permit me to visit officially as a member of the Senate Committee for Military Affairs a number of military establishments en route."

Senator Lundeen was killed in the crash of an airplane at Lovettsville, Va., August 31, 1940. Senator Holman, a Republican, has served in the Senate since 1938. He was defeated in the recent primary election.
