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

Batchelor and Secret Service Agents Sorrels and Lawson drove along the parade route in advance, "As Lawson suggested the speeds and timed the route, Assistant Chief Batchelor wrote down the number of men to be assigned at each intersection."³⁴ But there was noone in Dealey Plaza—no-one looking at the windows, checking the manholes, the rooftops.³⁵

The limousine was supposed to be seventh in line, but somehow ended up behind the lead car.³⁶ It could not go faster than the lead car, with Police Chief Curry in it. The press bus usually goes just ahead of the President, and it was supposed to be in this motorcade. But it ended up at the very end of the motorcade, the fourteenth vehicle.³⁷ This of course prevented the press from filming the assassination.
