I enclose a list of Dallas FBI agents as of 11/22/63.


The name Bill Townley is not familiar.

I received your address from AARC in Washington, DC.

I am trying to find out the names of the FBI agents who in Dallas on the 23 of November, 1963. I am in particular looking for the name of one agent who would also have been stationed in Dallas in the summer of 1954.

There was an episode involving a friend of mine, the FBI and Clint Murchison and Bill Townl(e)y. I do not expect you to have heard of Mr. Townley.

If you know the names of the agents I would appreciate a copy. The AARC said that they would forward them to me if you sent them a copy; or you can send me a copy at my home address. If you would like a copy of my information I will send written material upon request.

I think we would both agree that the leadership vacuum in our government at the time of the assassination was the biggest crime of all.
